UN World Youth Report—Canadian Perspective

There has been a global shift from long-term employment contracts and permanent work to shortterm contracts, temporary employment and casual work, and growing numbers of youth are turning to self -employment or the informal sector for lack of other options. These trends have effectively limited youth access to labour rights, benefits and entitlements (including social supports and public services), as precarious workers have few job prospects and are not in a strong position to bargain.-Amy Huziak, CLC
